



Paper Plate Butterfly



1. Fold a paper plate in half to make two wings.
2. Color each wing with bright shapes and dots.
3. Tape a craft stick to the middle for the body.
4. Add two paper strips on top for the feelers.

A grown-up helps with:

1. Trim the craft stick with scissors if it is too long.

What will you name your paper plate butterfly?

- Grown-ups handle the scissors
- blunt, kid-safe ones
- and clean up small bits.

Ages 3-7 - made by a teacher, adapt freely.
